Good Afternoon Gentlemen,

Welcome to the 2022 Lookout Point Men's League. On the eve of the opening tee shots going in the air, I want to take a moment to not only thank this year's players, captains, and sponsors for adding another chapter to our legacy in such a historic year, but also pay our respects to those who came before us, stood beside us, and now forever remain in the heritage and lore of this league.

To the returning individuals that previously received the welcome email a few weeks ago with the advanced sign up, there will be a few items here that will be echoed again, however I wanted to ensure we included as much detail as possible to both new and returning players.

Cost

Firstly, regarding cost of the league. The league charge will remain the same at \$200+HST with event entries for Mega Party (August 11th), and Men's Closing Banquet (September 22nd) going up to \$15+HST per player. We have adjusted prizing and payout structures to add as much value as possible back for every player to

compete for shop credit, centennial prizing, and some individual achievement awards throughout the year.

Format

The league this year consists of 8 teams that will be made up of 25 players and 1 captain. Each week, teams are scheduled in a head-to-head matchup against one another. At the end of the regular season, the team with the most points will win the regular season and teams will be seeded accordingly heading for the three weeks of playoffs starting the first Thursday in September. Scoring will consist of *10 Net Scores & 1 Gross Score* that will make up the team's total.

Teams will receive 2 points for a win.

Teams will also have a 2 vs. 2 Captain's pick head-to-head matchup that will award 1 extra point to a team's weekly result.

A weekly max of 3 points to the winning team is available with a weekly minimum of zero.

All season & weekly scoring will be available on our <u>League's Golf</u>

<u>Genius</u> site. Weekly updates will also be available the following afternoon on isitthursdayyet.ca

Individual scoring will be tracked throughout the year with prizing awarded to each team's top performer as well as the top 4 low average net and low average gross players spanning over the entire 18-week season. Individual scoring is as follows:

INDIVIDUAL WEEKLY SCORING

- Recording a score is worth 1 point.
- A net score of 37 is worth 1 point.
- A net score of 36 is worth 2 points.
- A net score of 35 is worth 3 points.
- A net score of 34 is worth 4 points.

- A net score of 33 or lower is worth 5 points.

Maximum 9-hole handicap of 18 will be in effect

Weekly Games

Low Net & Low Gross will remain the same in a two-flight structure based on handicap. Individuals with a handicap of +4 – 6 will compete in one flight while anyone with a 7 or above will compete in the second flight. This same structure will be implemented in skins with the lower handicap flight being gross skins and the higher handicap flight being net skins. This allows for larger skin payouts and rewarding some of the fantastic shots that happen every Thursday.

The weekly **closest to the pin** competitions will be returning on all par 3s every week with the winner of each taking home a sleeve of balls. There will be a feature par 3 every week that offers the chance to win a personalized headcover as well as a shot in our newest competition, *Men's League Shootout*. The shootout will consist of a winner takes all, closest to the pin shot from 100 yards on the 18th hole with the winners from weeks 1-9 competing at Mega Party and the winners of weeks 10-18 competing at Men's

Closing. Feature Holes for upcoming weeks will be mentioned in the weekly recaps however the schedule is as follows:

Hole 2: Weeks 1,4,7,10,13,16

Hole 5: Weeks 2,5,8,11,14,17

Hole 8: Weeks 3,6,9,12,15,18

We will also be giving out a 4-pack of our Lookout Point Pilsner each week to the *highest net score* in the field to help drink some of the sorrows away after a tough day on the golf course! A bottle of Gentleman Jack will also continue to be given out each week to a gentleman who had something extraordinary happen on the golf course or who has been extraordinary off it, so please be sure to keep the stories coming to any member of the Golf Shop.

WEATHER POLICY

51% of League participants must play that given day for scoring and sweeps to count.

Please refer to the section of the website for help on downloading or using the app. With that said, the Golf Shop will still be taking scorecards and inputting them for those that are not interested in using the app.
