Brrr! The Men's League kicked off with a chilly start as we braved the elements to swing our clubs and conquer the course. Despite the cold, our enthusiasm thawed out any doubts, and we tackled the challenges with gusto.

We want to start off with our Biggest Thanks to Walker Construction – John Blake. Your weekly sponsorship is greatly appreciated, and the league couldn't do it without your support.

Tees Up!

First up, the new edge tees. Ah yes, those little squares of turf that seem to have a mind of their own. If you've found yourself muttering expletives under your breath while trying to tee off, you're not alone. But fear not, fellow golfers, for relief is on the horizon! After hearing your collective cries of frustration, we've devised a brilliant solution that will have you teeing off with confidence in no time. We are bringing back **The Old Edge Tees. Moving forward Men's League will play 1,2,3,5,6, from the Blues and 4,7,8,9 from the whites.** We hope that this will help alleviate a lot of the concern that we heard from our men's league members. We will have them predominantly marked so that you know that you are playing the right ones. Score cards will be provided on your golf cart or from the pro shop / starter. Please ensure you hand in your cards after your 9 holes to the pro shop and before 9 pm.

Handicaps, they are a-changing.

We are working out the logistics with the Golf Genius system and learning its strengths and limitations. One result is we will be moving to using a Golf Canada handicap as this new system allows handicap factors to be directly loaded from Golf Canada. It means all games played (not just men's league games) will be factored in, resulting in a more representative handicap. (Less sand bagging than the best 3 out of 5 men's league scores used in prior years.) A 9-hole handicap will be calculated for either the front or back nine depending on what we will be playing. So, its important that everyone loads their scores when playing any round. It is very beneficial that each player enters their score hole by hole as this will reflect a true handicap.

Closest to the pin, or closest to a disaster

Now, let's talk about the curious case of the Closest to the Pin (CTTP) cards. Did you notice something a bit off? Perhaps a typo here or a printing error there? Well, fear not, it wasn't just a hallucination induced by the cold. Rest assured, we're on top of it. This week, we'll be rolling out the corrected cards faster than you can say "Mulligan." Hence, They will be better marked this week. And for your reference, each flight is sponsored, "**A**" Flight is **Youngs Insurance**, "**B**" Flight is **1 Hour Signs**, "**C**" Flight is **Hill Boles Automotive**, and "**D**" Flight is **C.S Contracting Ltd**. Why four flights in the first place, so we can spread the wealth as far as prizes over a field of 224 golfers, so even Saplywy and Smallman have a chance.

So, before you head out for your round, be sure to check your flight status. Wouldn't want to accidentally end up in first class when you're more of a coach kind of guy, right?

Live results are available in the Golf Genius App. When logging in, use the GGID code **LPCCML2024** to see how your team is doing in real time. That code will be good for the entire year. Other information such as personal points, handicap information, Captains Picks will be loaded into the www.isitthursdayyet.ca web site on Friday after results are in. You can download the app on your Cell Phone (IOS or Android device) in your app store. It is totally free. (Pic of app below) Once you have downloaded the APP please enter the code into the GGID Line and then you will get a black screen. Hit, Leader Board and all the information will be there.
